



L As in “fast and loose,” used when a rider is looking fast, aggressive and stylish




Used to describe intimidating or technical trails or features, just “gnar” may substitute

GNARLY




STEEZE

Style and ease in one! Making the work look effortless and natural, Steezy can also be applicable here.




STOKED!

Riding at ones absolute limit, and committing to a line with expert skill


SHREDDING

wooden features on a trail creating a narrow path




Flipping or falling Over The Bars in a crash
